**“Making Promises?”**

**SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTISTS BELIEVE:**

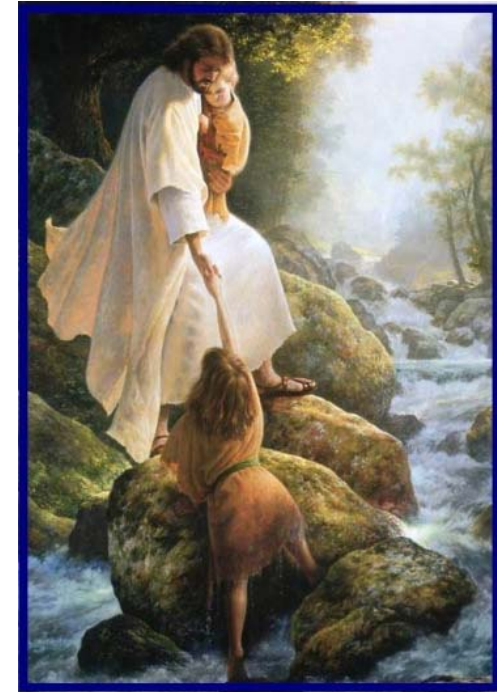
