I = *Inspiring* Is what we are about to say **INSPIRING**?

Malachi 3:16 (NIV) "Then those who feared the Lord talked with each other, and the Lord listened and heard. A scroll of remembrance was written in His presence concerning those who feared the Lord and honored His name."

N = *Necessary* Is what we are about to say **NECESSARY**?

Proverbs 17:27&28 A wise person does not do a lot of talking.

K = *Kind* Is what we are about to say **KIND**?

Matthew 12:34-37 Kindness has to come from the heart.

Galatians 5:20&21 Kindness (NIV) or gentleness (KJV) is a fruit of the Holy Spirit.
