SERMON NOTES

“Limits of Authority”

- I. For Government
 The higher authority is God
 1. We ought to obey God rather than men. Acts 5:29
- II. For the Church
 The higher authority is God’s Word.
 1. Search the Scriptures daily. Acts 17:11.
 2. Some teach commandments of men. Mark 7:6-9.
- III. For Marriage
 The higher authority is God and safety in the home.
 1. Submit as unto the Lord. Ephesians 5:22.
 2. Submit as it is fit in the Lord. Colossians 3:18.
 3. Staying in a difficult relationship may have eternal consequences. I Corinthians 7:13-16
- IV. For God
 The higher authority is our choice.
 1. God allows evil. Isaiah 45:7. In order to have freedom of choice, two alternatives must exist. God lovingly allowed (or created the possibility of) created beings disagreeing with Him (choosing evil) so that they could truly have freedom of choice, develop accordingly, and intelligently serve Him. God did not cause Lucifer to sin (Ezekiel 28:15). Lucifer simply exercised his power of choice and chose to disagree with God. After the controversy is ended, the universe will be secure for all will have seen the results of disagreeing with God and will have intelligently chosen to serve Him.
 2. Choose who you will serve. Joshua 24:15.
 3. Choose life or death. Deuteronomy 30:19.
 4. Whosoever will let him take of the water of life. Revelation 22:17.
- V. For us individually
 The higher authority is God and His Word.
 1. Life without limits could lead to death. Proverbs 14:12.
 2. Those who bring God into their lives will receive His guidance. Proverbs 3:5,6.
 3. God’s Word provides us with light for our path. Psalm 119:105.

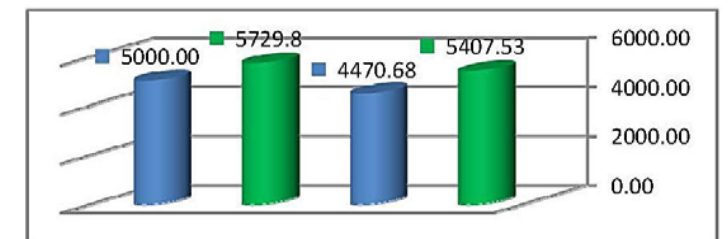

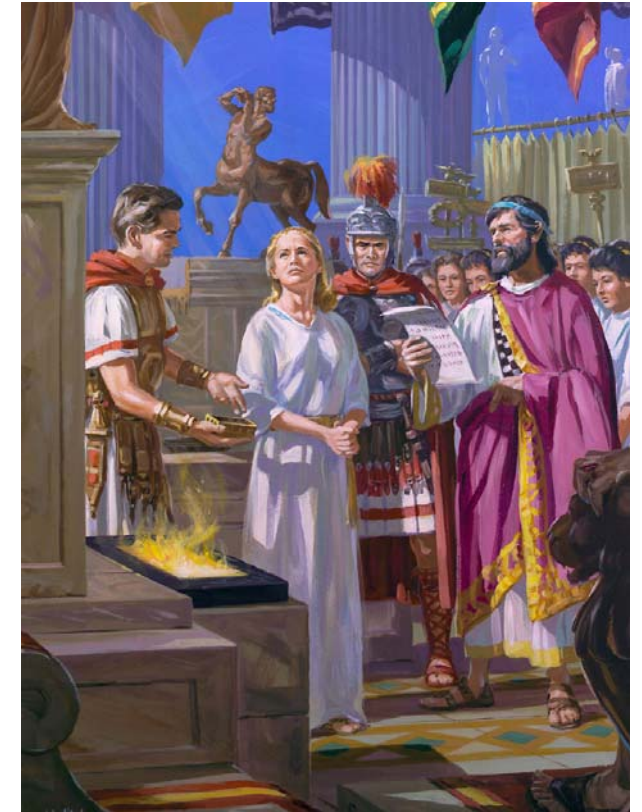
