SERMON NOTES

“The Leopard and Righteousness by Faith”

- I. There must be something that I can do to change.
 1. We can’t change—Jeremiah 13:23.
 2. We can’t do anything more—Isaiah 64:6.
 3. We must be born again—John 3:3-6.

- II. Before we can be born again, we must die.
 1. The old man (leopard) is to be crucified.
 2. After the crucifixion, Christ is able to live in us by faith—Galatians 2:20.
 3. It is impossible for anyone to crucify themselves.

- III. Righteousness by Faith is not something more for us to do.
 1. With man nothing is possible—with God all things are possible—Mark 10-26-27.
 2. All things are possible if we believe—Mark 9:23.
 3. Righteousness by faith is not something that we do but something that we allow Christ to do in us. Ephesians 2:10.

- IV. Why is our righteousness connected to faith and not works?
 1. Righteousness could be earned—Romans 4:1-5.
 2. We could boast—Ephesians 2:8,9.
 3. Works is a human commodity but faith comes only from God—Romans 12:3.
 4. God controls faith. If you want faith you have to come to Him or His word—Romans 10:17.
 5. God’s righteousness is only revealed through faith—Romans 1:16, 17 and John 3:16.

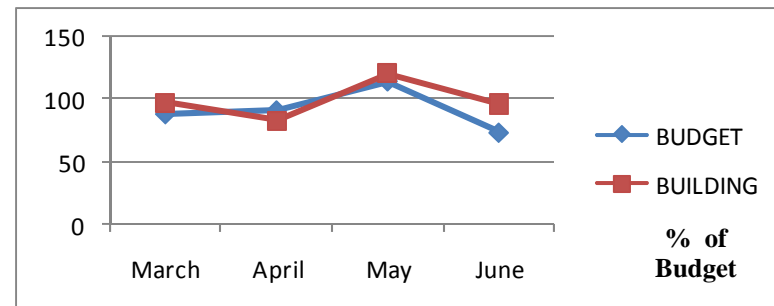
