

## “Living for Eternity”

I. We have been created for eternity because we have been loved from eternity.  
Jeremiah 31:3

II. God has put this sense that we were created for eternity in our hearts. “He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the hearts of men; yet they cannot fathom what God has done from beginning to end.”  
Ecclesiastes 3:11 NIV

III. Eternity or eternal life is only found in Jesus. 1 John 5:11&12

IV. Eternity or eternal life comes when we believe (rest completely in Jesus). 1 John 5:13

V. Eternity or eternal life comes when we learn to know Him as our best friend.  
John 17:3

VI. We pass from death to eternity or eternal life when love takes the place of hate in our hearts. 1 John 3:13-15

VII. Jesus tells us that perfect love for the problem people in our life comes through prayer. Matthew 5:43-48

VIII. If we live according to our sinful desires, we will die. But if we allow the Holy Spirit to put to death our sinful desires we shall live for eternity. Romans 8:13&14
