He was a school administrator in a variety of educational settings, ranging from private Christian schools to the Florida, juvenile prison system. For fifteen years Paul was self- employed, owning several different businesses. From March of 2000 until December of 2003, Paul continued to operate his family business and began the foundational work of the People of Peru Project. In January of 2004, he shut the doors of the business and entered into this project on a full-time basis.

Sandra Opp is the secretary/treasurer of People of Peru Project. She has been enthusiastically "on board" since the very beginning. Sandi has a heart for people in need and is compelled to feed anyone that is hungry. She graduated from college with a degree in food service, nutrition and bakery management and has worked in the food service industry in several different educational and medical institutions.
