Our Beliefs in Brief: #10-The Experience of Salvation

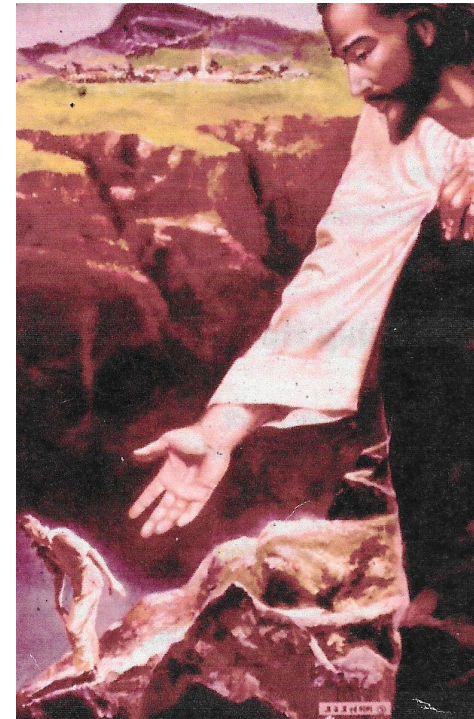
