## I. Introduction

- A. Sacrifice is no longer politically correct. But we are continually making sacrifices in the choices that we make. We sacrifice something good for something not as good.
- B. What is worship? Could it be more than a feeling? **Luke 7:36-39** gives the best definition of worship. Worship is love's response in sacrifice.
- C. The Communion Service. Could this turn into a meaningless ritual? Like what is described in **Isaiah 1:11**? Or could this be an occasion for Heart Worship like that which David experienced in **Psalms 51:16&17**?

## II. The Ordinance of Humility. What is the sacrifice?

- A. Pride and selfishness. **Luke 22:24-27** and **John 13:5-17**

## III. The Communion Bread. What is the sacrifice?

- A. That which dilutes the power of God's Word. **Matthew 4:4**

## IV. The Communion Grape Juice. What is the sacrifice?

- A. Stop trying to save ourselves.
  - 1. This is the blood of the new testament or covenant. **Matthew 26:27&28**
  - 2. With the new covenant or testament, God writes His law on our hearts. **Hebrews 8:10**
  - 3. As we labor to co-operate and surrender to Him, He works out His salvation in us. **Colossians 1:27-29**
