Our church district has recently grown to three congregations with the addition of Cave Junction. The town has a population of 2071 and it is named for the Oregon Caves National Monument. The caves were discovered in 1874.

Cave Junction has had a Seventh-day Adventist church and school for many years. Pray for the continued success of these spiritual lighthouses, now yoked with Brookings and Gold Beach. The Bible speaks of 3 cities that were set aside by Moses (Deuteronomy, 4:41).

The pastor begins preaching at the new church in June. Pray that God will bless the three towns of Gold Beach, Brookings, and Cave Junction in the days ahead.

Lemon Blueberry Bread

1 1/2 c flour

1 tsp baking powder

1 tsp salt

1/3 c granulated sugar

2 eggs

1/2 tsp vanilla extract 2 tsp lemon zest 2 T lemon juice

1/2 c milk or milk substitute 1 c blueberries

Glaze:

2 T butter, melted 1/2 c powdered sugar 2 T fresh lemon juice 1/2 ts vanilla extract

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F and line a 9"x5" loaf pan with parchment paper (or lightly grease with butter).
- In a medium bowl, whisk the flour, baking powder and salt. and set aside.
- 3. In another bowl, use an electric mixer to blend together the melted butter, sugar, eggs, vanilla, lemon zest and lemon iuice. Mix until well combined.
- 4. While mixing, add flour mixture and milk in to batches. Stop mixing as soon as it's just combined.
- 5. Rinse blueberries (if fresh) so they have a bit of moisture, toss them with 1 T flour to coat.
- 6. Pour batter in to pan and bake for 55-65 minutes until toothpick comes clean from the center.
- 7. Prepare glaze by whisking together the melted butter, powdered sugar, lemon juice and vanilla, then pour glaze over the loaf. Allow to set a few minutes, then enjoy!


